Youth Development Officer (3 year period)	\$330,000 (\$110,000 per year)	Request from Coolah Progress Association. Also note Council's previous resolution to seek funding to develop a Youth Strategy.
6 Prefabricated Grandstands to be located at 2 x Coona, 2 x Baradine and 2 x Mendooran	\$135,000	
6 Commercial Quality Basketball Posts, backboard and Hoops mounted on 15m x 10m concrete pads located at Coona, Coolah, Baradine, Dunedoo, Binnaway and Mendooran	\$70,000	
Mendooran Park play equipment	\$100,000	The existing play equipment is in poor condition, it is also very outdated and not attractive as children's play equipment. The Development Group in Mendooran have worked with Council to replace the equipment.
Mendooran Sportsground oval fence	\$100,000	A fence around the perimeter of the oval has been the subject of two previous funding applications. The project has been requested by the Community Town Consultation Meetings.
Dunedoo Milling Park skate park shade cover	\$60,000	This request has been raised at Dunedoo Town Consultation Meetings
Dunedoo Pool amenities building	\$600,000	The existing amenities are in poor condition and renewal has been requested at town consultation meetings and it has been the subject of previous funding applications.
Coonabarabran Oval No 3 equipment storage sheds	\$220,000	The Rugby Club and Soccer Club store their training equipment in separate shipping containers. The containers are in poor condition.

Installation of small toilet block at new courts Coonabarabran	\$240,000	There are likely to be difficulties in connecting to the sewerage system
Coolah Bowen Oval – Skate Park	\$200,000	A funding application has been submitted under the My Community Projects program for \$162,950
Baradine Hall, reroofing and maintenance	\$190,000	This is a priority of the Baradine Progress Association
