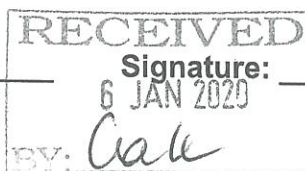

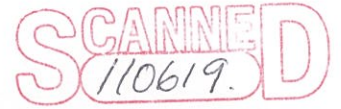

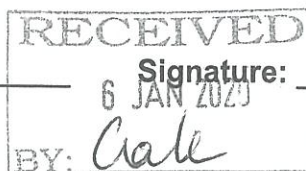

BRAGATTS GULLY approx 20 km from Coolah, large culvert appears to be in good order but bitumen surface is deformed. During 2018, patching was done and caution Reduce Speed signs erected.
The surface may need constant patching plus points at top of gully each end where there are weak points on roadside. Cassilis end blind corner has deteriorated, Coolah side subsidence

Because of the steep incline both sides of gully, trailers were observed to become airborne and/or jumping sideways. 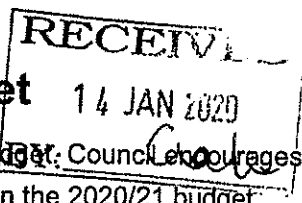



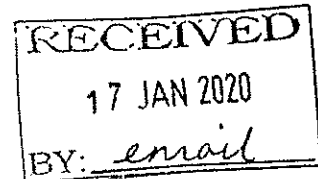

Re: Submission – Draft Operational Plan for 2020/21

In response to the draft Operational Plan 2020/21, please find the below submission relating to recycling charges, noted in the draft plan on page 13 of Part 4 Revenue Policy Fees and Charges 2020/2021.

As per the draft plan, commercial (non-domestic) recycling collection will incur a charge of \$241 with 323 users being levied the charge. This in total will raise \$77,843 in revenue to fund the commercial recycling costs across the LGA during 2020/21.

In accordance with previous year's budget, Council has expended \$85,180 in wages to provide commercial recycling collection services, as well as \$51,654 in plant costs, leading to a total annual cost of \$136,834.

At present, the charge of \$241 per user as provided within the draft plan, will not cover the cost for Council to provide commercial recycling, and will lead to a shortfall of at least \$58,991 during the 2020/2021 financial year.

Further to that, over the past years, users of the commercial recycling collection service have been charged for one commercial charge per year, with unlimited amounts of recyclable materials being placed out for collection by Council staff in woolpacks. However, some businesses have more than one woolpack, and should be charged an additional charge for each woolpack collected.

Whilst Council continues to provide commercial recycling in its current format, the annual charge should be increased to meet the costs to provide the service. In this scenario, the cost of providing the service to businesses and non-domestic users within the LGA should be increased upwards to at least \$424 per user per woolpack; this is an estimated increase of \$183 per charge.

Alternatively, with the commercial recycling collection service currently under review, and potential cessation altogether, Council could opt to increase the user charges in part as opposed to full cost recovery.

Either way, Council needs to be charging more for the commercial (non-domestic) recycling collection service to cover costs, and this charge should be evenly distributed across all

users of the service with an individual charge per annum being levied per woolpack collected.

Aside from commercial recycling charges, Council should clearly state in the draft plan the charges for domestic recycling. At present, recycling charges for domestic waste are included in the overall domestic waste fee. It is not clearly stated the same charge is applicable if an additional recycling bin service is required by a domestic household.

On this basis, the following changes to the draft Operational Plan are suggested:

1. That the Commercial (Non-Domestic) Recycling Charge be increased from \$241 to \$424 to cover the cost of providing the commercial recycling service.
2. That additional woolpacks provided as part of the Commercial (Non-Domestic) Recycling Charge incur a further user charge per woolpack.
3. That additional recycling collections from Domestic Waste users incur a further user charge per recycle bin.
