- a) Official Opening

## b) Drainage and Carpark

Council is supplying the materials and the contractor will install the drainage and complete carpark earthworks. A discussion on the drainage specification was held and the scope of works explained to the Committee. A two-coat seal is likely to fit in the \$85,000 budget balance and will be coordinated once the drainage and carpark has been constructed.

## **GENERAL BUSINESS**

The following items were discussed without resolution:

- Cost of floodlights has not been sought due to competing priorities and may be factored into future program / projects development.
- Score boards quotation will be sent tonight.
- Media release must state that this facility is contemporary and caters for females. A discussion was held about the funds that had been spent on the entire Robertson Oval facility and the high calibre of the facilities that exist there today.
