Storms and floods have had a distressing and widespread impact across NSW in 2022. I know how devastating these recent events have been to your council area. I understand that most of the responsibility for co-ordinating emergency and recovery efforts will fall to your local council, and this will be a costly exercise.

To support impacted communities, the NSW Government in partnership with the Australian Government has announced significant recovery funding to assist disaster declared councils such as yours. This funding is provided under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) – Category D.

The Local Government Recovery Grants program is providing payment of \$1 million to your council upon confirmation of the Project Overview and the Grant Acknowledgement Schedule.

You will find attached to this letter:

- 1. The **NSW Local Government Recovery Grants Program Guideline** which provides detailed requirements of the grant including project criteria, eligible and ineligible projects, and administrative arrangements (with key dates). Further confirmation of reporting requirements with associated templates will be provided when finalised.
