Action Status on Procedure for the Closure of Part Castlereagh Avenue, Binnaway

In terms of the procedure, below is a summary of the action taken to date and further action now required 8-16 to complete the process.

- 1. Confirm road status: Is it a Council Road?
 - Yes. In a Gazette dated 22 June 2018 Council dedicates the land as a public road under s16 *Roads Act* 1933.
- 2. Is closure suitable as per s38A?

S38A provides that a council may propose the closure of a council public road for which it is the roads authority if:

- (a) The road is not reasonably required as a road for public use (whether for present or future needs), and
- (b) The road is not required to the provide the continuity for an existing road network, and
- (c) If the road provides means of vehicular access to particular land, another public road provides lawful and reasonably practicable vehicular access to that land.
 Hence, the closure is suitable.
- 3. Confirm vesting: does council intend to keep the road vested in council upon closure?

Yes, the closed part will remain in use as a recreational area and for the campground (it was previously a public reserve area).

- 4. Road will remain vested in council upon closure.
- 5. Council meeting: Does council want to initiate closure process based on information? Yes – undertaken.
- 6. Complete notification requirements.

Council must re-notify authorities listed in s32B *Roads Act* 1933 and s81 *Roads Regulation* 2018.

- S81(1) provides the following are notifiable authorities:
 - (a) A major utility or water supply authority
 - (b) Forestry Corporation
 - (c) Local Land Services
 - (d) The Office of Environment and Heritage

S81(2) the owner/ occupier of land whose land will suffer a material loss of access because of the council public road closure concerned is prescribed in s38B(1)(b)(iii) of the Roads Act. (COMPLETED)

S32B – A council that is proposing to close a council public road must cause notice of the proposal. (COMPLETED)

- (a) To be published in a local newspaper, and
- (b) To be given to
 - i. All owners of land adjoining the road, and
 - ii. All notifiable authorities, and
 - iii. Any other person prescribed the regulations. (COMPLETED)

As per previous correspondence there were two private objections that have been resolved and withdrawn.

- 7. Notifiable authority objection? No.
- Council will now consider all submissions and make decision on proposal. S38D(1): provides that after considering any submissions that have been duly made with respect to the proposal, the council may, by notice publish in the Gazette, close the public road concerned.
- Council advises relevant parties of decision. This will involve advising the previous notifiable authorities that the road will be closed.
- 10. Instruct surveyor to prepare and finalise a formal survey and deposited plan. (Survey and Plan of the proposed road to be closed previously prepared on 21 April 2020).
- 11. Lodge the Deposited Plan and Survey NSW Land Registry Services (notification of the closing of the road will appear in the Government Gazette following registration of the plan.)
- 12. Publish notice in the Gazette.
- 13. Wait for 60-day Land and Environment Court appeal period to expire prior to proceeding.
- 14. The land will vest in the Council upon closure effected by registration.
- 15. This will then create title for the closed road.
- 16. Council will receive the title for former council public road.
