



Conditions of Entry

All Shire Pool's are a Non Smoking Facility

Risk and Responsibility

Patrons must pay the applicable fee to enter the facility.

Children under the age of 12 months are not required to pay entry fee.

Pass-outs will only be issued for the lunch closure period.

No refunds will be available for bad weather.

All children under the age of ten (10) years **MUST** be accompanied by an appropriate parent or guardian.

All children under the age of five (5) years **MUST** be accompanied by an adult in or out of the water at all times.

In the interest of public health, Aqua Nappies **MUST** be worn for all Non Toilet Train Toddlers.

Swim toys, balls and the like may be used at the discretion of the supervisor on duty.

Inflatable boats and rafts, or inflatable bathing suits are not permitted in the pools.

It is recommended that you do not leave your valuables unattended. The Warrumbungle Shire accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen items.

Cameras and mobile phone cameras are not permitted in change rooms.

With the exception of guide dogs, pets or animals are not permitted into the facility.

Patron's bags may be searched.

Management reserves the right to refuse entry

Behaviour

All patrons must behave in a manner which keeps children safe from physical, sexual or emotional abuse, or the fear or apprehension of such abuse.

Patrons must adhere to instructions given by council lifeguards at all times.

Any patron under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted into the facility.

Gum chewing is not permitted anywhere in the pool area for health and safety reasons

No alcohol and intoxicating drugs or glass containers permitted into the facility.

No person within the pool area shall behave in such a manner as to jeopardize the safety and health of him/her and others. Such behaviour, including abusive, aggressive, antagonistic or profane language shall be grounds for expulsion.

Management reserve the right to prohibit further entry to any patron found to be in breach of the guidelines.

Attire

Be unsoiled prior to entering the pool.

All patrons within the pool area must be attired in swimming apparel. No street clothes are allowed in the pool. Clothing such as cut-offs, gym shorts and underwear is not permitted as swimwear. The wearing of suitable "Sun Safe Hats" in the water is permitted.

All clothing must be colourfast and lightweight material suitable for swimwear, such as Lycra, Spandex or Nylon.

T-shirts (including those for modesty or sun protection) are not permitted. Rash shirts, which are more tight-fitting, designed for in-water use and which offer protection from the sun, will be permitted.

Admission for school age children during school terms (school days)

School age children are generally prohibited between 9am – 2.30pm on school days unless:

Students are on an organized group visit with teachers or parents accompanying them. Students are accompanied by parents/carers within the guidelines of Conditions of Entry.

Students have signed permission authority and ID that permits them to access this facility by school or parents. Staff are permitted to verify this with a phone call to the relevant parent/school.

Known schools have indicated that they are not operating normal class times at a specific period and students are not required at school.
