Minute number 294/1415 RESOLVED that Council award the Contract for demolition of Kenebri Bridge and construction of a new bridge on the same road alignment and with a total length of 39 metres and carriageway width of 4.5 metres to Bridging Australia for a price of \$415,877 (incl GST).
