Just in regards to your email. I have spoken with a few elders on this, One has done a bit of research for me and has found that one of the names is correct and a local Gamilaraay word however the meaning is different.

The second suggestion isn't a Gamilaraay word to their knowledge. She has however given another suggestion on the second option which I will show below.

<u>Biruu</u>, meaning "long way" <u>Gaba</u>- Meaning, "good" "Biruu Gaba Road"

The suggestion she has come up with is: Bagay, meaning "creek"- or river Gali, —"water"

"Bagay Gali Drive"
