The Jump the Stump Park would like to request approval from Council for the use of the site above the playground area at Bowen Oval to build a Skate Park and Learn to Bike Ride Track.

In strengthening our application, please find attached seven letters of support from local user groups of Bowen Oval. There are four letters of support which have been requested but not returned. These are from Coolah Lions, Coolah Touch Football Association, Coolah Development Group and Coolah Junior Sports.

The Coolah District Development Group have agreed to be our sponsor for the My Community Project application and will write a letter of support for the Skate Park and Learn to Bike Ride Track early next week.

Coolah Junior Sports have also said they are in favour of the project and the location however haven't finished their letter yet.

Our committee understands that Coolah Touch Football Association have concerns over the location of the project and we have requested the committee put their concerns as a Committee and send us a response.

If Council is agreeable to granting conditional access to our preferred site, we will hold a public meeting to provide another opportunity for discussion and strategies to manage concerns.

Additional information attached to this email is the concept plan provided by Oasis Skate Parks. The purpose of this design is for the grant application to My Community Project and to demonstrate that a skate park can be constructed within the given dimensions. The concept design is not the final design idea for the park.

The Jump the Stump Park Committee have also included information provided at the Council Consultation Meetings and in the Coolah Diary Publications.

We would like Council to consider the possible removal of trees on the site above the playground and for further financial support. We applied for \$10,000, from within the 2019/2020 Council budget, to pay the professional design of the skate park and learn to ride bike track.

Our Committee appreciates the previous support of \$500 from the Council and looks forward to further discussions of this project with Council in the near future.
