Hotchkiss Road Community member advised that the road has started to deteriorate near the culvert and requires patching; there is also a pothole on the culvert.</p> <p>ACTION: A/DTS to investigate and action patching of the road.</p>	TS	<p>20.01.22 – Road graded and culvert patched. Recent storms have caused further road damage and these repairs will be done in priority order over the coming months.</p> <p>01.03.22 – Superseded by Council Resolution No 206/2122 of 17 February 2022 – <i>‘that Council request a report on the possibility of extending the maintenance of Hotchkiss Road another 2.8km from the current end point. This would mean that Council would maintain the first 5.6km of Hotchkiss Road from the intersection of Gulargambone Road.’</i> A report is currently being prepared.</p> <p>07.07.22 – Report on July 2022 Council meeting agenda.</p> <p>01.08.22 – Council last completed repairs on the maintained section of Hotchkiss Road in February 2022. Council maintains 2.8km of this road. Maintenance of the unformed road (as per definition in Asset Management Plan 2019) was considered by Council at their July Council meeting and they decided to keep status quo which means that no maintenance will be done to the unformed road</p> <p>12.10.22 – The maintained section of Hotchkiss Road was damaged by recent floods. Focus is 3-5 years for access and inclusion.</p> <p>Older residents are getting socially isolated due to unsafe paths as there is only one shop accessible by wheelchair in town</p> <p>ACTION: DCCS to liaise with Community for local inclusion in the DIAP</p>	CCS	<p>Disability ACTION Plan (DIAP) currently under review. Included for completion 2020/21– this is on ongoing document</p> <p>Strategy to be observed is this will be an item on the Progress Association/Development Groups agendas and hence Council can obtain a monthly account of local DIAP developments /initiatives.</p> <p>25.01.2022 – The Disability Inclusion Action Plan has been under review but delayed due to Covid and staff unavailability</p> <p>29.09.2022 – New Manager Community Services has commenced. Manager will liaise with community in the ensuing months on DIAP.</p>	In Progress
