<p><b>Mollyann Road</b> Residents enquired on result of road survey (number of vehicles etc.) on the Binnaway – Mollyann Road to determine if road marking would be undertaken. Council advised that this information would be supplied at the next meeting.</p>	TS	The Average Annual Daily Traffic count for Mollyan Road is 187. Roads and Maritime Service (RMS) guidelines indicate that road centre lines should be marked when traffic count exceeds 300 per day.	Completed
<p><b>George and Renshaw Streets</b> An update was requested on George and Railway Streets and the channel running from the Showground to Railway Street. It was also raised that there has been illegal dumping of rubbish in this area. Council advised they would follow up on the issue and report back to the next meeting.</p>	TS	Modifications to the channel have been undertaken.	Completed
<p><b>Len Guy Park</b> An update was requested on the installation of softfall in Len Guy Park. Director Technical Services (DTS), Kevin Tighe, advised the meeting that the amount set aside in the current budget is insufficient to complete the work required. The money will remain set aside in the new financial years budget and Council will consider increasing the amount so as to get the work completed.</p>	TS	Has been added to 2018/2019 Capital Works Program with correct budget. <p><b>Dump Site</b></p> <p>It was raised at the meeting that the primitive camp site has been a great success and is very popular but there is a problem with some people using the site dumping their waste in the toilet facilities. It was requested that Council investigate a sites for the installation of a dump site to resolve this problem.</p>	DS	Investigations underway. Possible site at Binnaway Railway Barracks is being considered along with other alternative sites.	In progress
<p><b>Town Sewerage</b></p> <p>The meeting discussed the installation of a sewerage system in Binnaway. Director Technical Services, Kevin Tighe, advised the meeting that an Expression of Interest had been lodged with the NSW Government and further work would be required to even plan these works. Kevin advised that there would be a lengthy community consultation process before any final decision was made.</p>	TS	Funding application has been made to prepare a business case for the project.	Completed
<p><b>Kerbside Pickup</b></p> <p>Residents advised Council that many of them had only become aware of the kerbside pickup after it was completed. Residents felt that it would have been better supported if more people knew about it. Council was reminded that not all residents read the local publications or have social media. Council were asked to consider a letter box drop in the future as per the water restriction notices.</p>	DS	. Next kerbside pickup yet to be determined. <p><b>Collery Bridge</b></p> <p>Residents raised concerns about the appearance of the bridge. Council were asked to consider repainting and repairing the bridge. DTS, Kevin Tighe, explained that he believes that the bridge is painted in lead paint. This has implications in relation to both cost and the nature of the works to be completed.</p>	TS	Repainting of the bridge railing has commenced.	Completed

<p><b>Binnaway Central School</b></p> <p>Council enquired as to the status of Binnaway Central School. School Principal, Ken White, advised the meeting that the decision regarding the school had been deferred for six (6) months following which he would have more news. Currently enrolments for Primary School have remained steady. It is hoped that enrolments will sustain and then increase in High School. The school currently has 45 enrolments.</p>	CCS	No action required.	No action required

<p><b>Oak Valley – Gamble Creek Road</b></p> <p>Concerns were raised regarding works in this area. It was requested that works be completed. Council advised that they need advice on this project in relation to soil conservation. Soil Conversation people are currently working on projects with Council. When these projects are finished they can start on this project. The completion of these works is on Council's list. Progress will be reported at the next meeting.</p>	TS	Investigation of long term options to control erosion are still being investigated. In the meantime a section of the gully will be filled with rock to stabilise erosion.	In progress
<p><b>Pumphouse Campground – Septic Problems</b></p> <p>Residents highlighted issues with the septic at the Pumphouse Campground. There is no dump point due to there not being sewerage. It was however suggested that there are dump points that don't require sewage. Council will investigate whether or not one of these can be installed.</p>	TS	Legislation prevents the installation of a dump point in this location (septic is within 100m of a river).	Completed
<p><b>Mow Rock Brigade</b></p> <p>A resident enquired about this as they had heard the funds are there. Council advised that it has had to go to the Roads and Maritime Service (RMS). Council committed to following up to see where this is at.</p>	DS	Project has commenced.	In progress

<p><b>Softfall – Len Guy Park</b></p> <p>Residents raised concerns about the softfall in Len Guy Park needing replacing. Council advised that it was patched 2 years ago, however it does need further patching or replacement. There is a funding allocation of \$20,000 in the budget however, replacement will cost around \$32,000.</p>	TS	Refer to actions from 19/3/2018 meeting.	Refer to 19/3/2018
<p><b>Mow Rock Road</b></p> <p>Concerns were raised about the state of Mow Creek Road. It was noted that it was graded around two (2) years ago. Council confirmed it is on the list to be graded.</p>	TS	Not scheduled. Category 3 = every five (5) years.	Completed
<p><b>Town Sewerage</b></p> <p>Residents asked about any progress in relation to the installation of sewerage in Binnaway. Council advised that the NSW Government has announced the Safe and Secure Water Program. This program will provide co-funding that will target water and sewerage projects in regional NSW to ensure infrastructure meets contemporary standards for water security, public health, environmental and safety outcomes into the future. The program will provide co-funding to successful applicants such as local Councils, water utilities, water corporations and prescribed dam owners for detailed planning and construction activities to install, augment or decommission water and sewerage infrastructure. The program includes an Expression of Interest process followed by a full application. Council has lodged an EOI under this program for sewerage for Binnaway. If successful in the EOI process, Council will commence a full application which will include preparation of a business case and extensive community consultation.</p>	TS	Refer to actions from 19/3/2018 meeting. <p><b>Dip In Road – Renshaw Street and Warrumbungle Way</b></p> <p>It was unclear who placed this item on the Agenda. Those in attendance noted that the dip is there to help in slowing people down. It was noted that there is a sign but it might not be as visible as it could be. Council indicated they would check the location and visibility of the sign and move if required.</p>	TS	The meeting was advised that it is not economical feasible to remove the dip. Instead, road markings and signage will be renewed as required.	Completed
<p><b>Unsealed Roads</b></p> <p>Residents highlighted that Ironbark Road is the only road in town not sealed. Residents recommended that this road be sealed. It was suggested that this project be put forward for funding as part of Council's budget process.</p> <p>Residents also raised concerns about Leader Road. It was reported that there are barriers to double decker stock trucks getting to properties, as well as other issues. Issues are currently being addressed by local landholders.</p> <p>Concerns were also raised by residents in relation to Box Ridge Road. It was reported that issues with the road are resulting in vehicles being damaged. Council advised that a grader will be heading out to Box Ridge Road this week – subject to water being available. Residents offered to supply water. Council advised they would discuss the offer to provide water after the meeting.</p>	TS	<p>There is no funding available for these works. <b>Binnaway New Mollyan Road</b> Council was asked when the centre lines on the Binnaway New Mollyan Road were going to be re-painted. Council advised that there is a move away from line marking local roads. The community felt that the lines needed to be marked.
