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<p><b>13. Wingabutta Road – Cars getting stuck in sand at the causeway. Is there a potential longer-term solution to the sand build up? The overall condition of the road is poor and it requires grading.</b></p> <p>DTS advised that Wingabutta Road will be graded in the next few months. The causeway has the same issue as others in the Shire and sand can only be cleaned up periodically. Council has sought State Government assistance and waiting to hear back. Costs are prohibitive.</p> <p><b>ACTION:</b> DTS: - Grading and sand clean up at causeway to occur at Wingabutta Road. DTS to advise of response from State Government.</p>	DTS	08.06.21 – Completed – sand removed.	Completed.
<p><b>14. Binnaway Tennis Court – Hole in court issue was raised at the last meeting with Council where the club was asked to come up with a plan.
