<p>1. Stormwater drainage at Binnaway Showground Request for an update on stormwater drainage off Cypress Street entering into the Binnaway Showground. The Mayor and Director Technical Services met on site approximately 12 months ago, and advised the problem was being investigated. Since then a survey has been completed.</p> <p>A/DTS advised the survey revealed an open drain will not be effective, and Council now looking at options for a pipeline. A/DTS requested an on-site inspection; to liaise with Jim Larkin after the meeting to make arrangements.</p> <p>ACTION: A/DTS to arrange for inspection of Binnaway Showground, in particular the areas affected by stormwater runoff.</p>	TS	<p>20.01.22 – DTS met with Jim Larkin on site. Design team have inspected and are developing a workable solution. 01.03.22 – Design completed, works to be programmed.</p>	In Progress
<p>2. Mowing at Binnaway Showground Jim Larkin congratulated Council staff on their efforts in maintaining the Binnaway oval, footpaths, and street edges, and for the mowing that takes place at the Binnaway Showground. Normally there is one event per year at the Showground, but there has been eight (8) events held there in recent months. Due to the increased usage, Mr Larkin requested that more regular mowing at the Binnaway Showground be included in Council's works program.</p> <p>GM advised that budgetary impacts of extra mowing would need to be assessed, including what other services may need to be reduced.</p> <p>A/DTS advised that the Urban Services works schedules across the LGA are being reviewed.</p> <p>ACTION: A/DTS to review the schedule of works for Urban Services, and to consider including the Binnaway Showground and cemetery maintenance in the review.</p>	TS	<p>20.01.22 – DTS met with Jim Larkin on site. Manager Urban Services also met with Jim Larkin on site. Mr Larkin provided with costs to carry out extra mowing and advised that there is no budget to carry out the schedule requested. Recommended that a submission be made to the Annual Budget. 01.03.22 – Submission received from Show Society for draft annual budget</p>	In Progress

Binnaway Swimming Pool Season ACTION: A/DTS to investigate registering Council to receive Active Kids Vouchers towards the cost of family season tickets. The first causeway on Leaders Roads was recently cemented, but has reopened after the rain, other side of causeway now needs cementing ACTION: A/DTS to investigate the first causeway on Leaders Road	TS	20.01.22 – Leaders Road has been inspected a number of times over the past few months to ensure it is safe and accessible. Where necessary, temporary repairs have been completed. There has been some damage to the road due to the recent storms and flood events. This damage is being recorded as part of Council's disaster recovery claim to the State Government.	In Progress

There was a request to seal remaining unsealed section of Ropers Road.</p> <p>ACTION: Consider the extension of the seal for Ropers Road.</p>	TS	20.01.22 – To seal the remaining unsealed sections of Ropers Road would cost approximately \$3.4 million including drainage. Road projects like this do require grant funding and often Council has to contribute 20–25% of the total cost to the project. At the moment Council does not have the resources to seal the road though will include it on the unfunded projects list.	In Progress

There was a request to install a ‘Concealed Driveway’ warning sign on Warrumbungle Way near the railway crossing.</p> <p>ACTION: A/DTS to action a request to install a ‘Concealed Driveway’ warning sign on Warrumbungle Way near the railway crossing.</p>	TS	21.01.22 – Sign ordered. 01.03.22 – TfNSW have advised that an 80km/h speed limit will be posted 400m either side of the railway crossing and potentially include the access to the landfill.
