3. Railway Crossing – Castlereagh Hwy (Dunedoo Road), last meeting we were advised council would be meeting with railway authority to discuss solutions;
4. Yarrow Road – closed now for 2.5 years and would like to know councils plan to reopen;

5. Yarrow Road - dip/causeway. Something needs to be done to better facilitate this site and re-open for commuters;
6. Mendooran Sports ground - Lighting assistance would be much appreciated to add capital with lighting of our grounds to enable increased use and expand opportunities for new sports all year round;
7. Main street (Bandulla) kerbside gutters and parking space rough and raised tree roots;
8. 27-29 Napier Street, in line with the Mendooran Preschool kerb/gutter area: this section is raised due to tree roots making an extremely unlevel parking space for Buses and families. Subsequently the level of the guttering has impeded on the preschool yard causing severe damage multiple times as our water is not able to exit to the street. We have made multiple insurance claims for damages and repairs but the cause is due to our water being unable to exit to the street;
9. Park - the basketball court nets have been located on the long sides of the cement court. Can these be altered to the short side like a normal court?
10. Signage to indicate both education facilities in our town - school and preschool
