#### **BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

The following matters were noted as outstanding:

- Black Stump Way Council request to NHVR that any road in the Warrumbungle Shire that is a 25 metre B Double Route be converted to a 26 metre B Double Route. *Matter to be followed up with Council's Director Technical Services.*
- Installation of end of road chevron at intersection of Dandry Road and Newell Highway – signs delivered and awaiting installation by TfNSW.
- Installation of timed bus zone on northern side of Bullinda Street at TrainLink bus stop – sign plan prepared. Awaiting confirmation from TfNSW on who is responsible for installation of the TrainLink timetable sign.
- Advance intersection warning signs for Werribee Road on Black Stump Way Council to finalise plan for advance side road name sign and forward to TfNSW to confirm design and specifications for order.

c) <u>'Give Way' Sign at Corner Hotchkiss Road and Goorianawa Road, Baradine</u>

2/2122 RECOMMENDED that due to very low traffic volumes, no crash history, sufficient sight distance and the fact that the road is a 'No Through' road, 'Give Way' signs are not warranted for Hotchkiss Road located at the Baradine Goorianawa Road intersection. Unicomb/Drooger

40kph Speed Zones for Coonabarabran and Dunedoo

Council at its meeting of 15 July 2021 resolved that feedback be sought through an advertising process on a proposal by TfNSW to investigate implementation of 40kph speed zones in both the Coonabarabran CBD and the Dunedoo CBD.

Questions were raised as to whether it was appropriate to have a 40kph speed zone in place at night and if a timed speed limit could be implemented as per school zones. TfNSW advise that at present the 40kph speed zones can only be implemented as a fulltime speed limit.

b) <u>Extension of Double Unbroken Lines on the Newell Highway from Gardener Street</u> to Dandry Road, Coonabarabran

Safety concerns were raised regarding overtaking vehicles and line markings on the Newell Highway from Gardener Street to Dandry Road, Coonabarabran. It was requested that double unbroken lines be extended on this section of road. The Committee determined that as the Newell Highway is a State Road the matter be referred to TfNSW for assessment and action.

c) <u>Installation of a Disabled Car Parking Space in Bolaro Street, Dunedoo</u> The Committee determined that further investigations, in relation to a suitable design and location, be undertaken for the installation of a disabled car parking space in Bolaro Street, Dunedoo.

d) <u>Installation of a 'Give Way' Sign on Baradine Goorianawa Road at the Intersection</u> of the Access Road into the Baradine Waste Depot

**5/2122 RECOMMENDED** that due to very low traffic volumes, no crash history, sufficient sight distance and the fact that the road is a 'No Through' road, 'Give Way' signs are not warranted for Baradine Waste Depot access road located at the Baradine Goorianawa Road intersection.
