### **BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

The following matters were noted as outstanding:

- Black Stump Way – Council request to NHVR that any road in the Warrumbungle Shire that is a 25 metre B Double Route be converted to a 26 metre B Double Route. *Matter to be followed up with Council's Director Technical Services.*
- Installation of end of road chevron at intersection of Dandry Road and Newell Highway – *awaiting installation by TfNSW.*
- Installation of timed bus zone on northern side of Bullinda Street at TrainLink bus stop – *sign plan prepared. Awaiting confirmation from TfNSW on who is responsible for installation of the TrainLink timetable sign.*
- Advance intersection warning signs for Werribee Road on Black Stump Way – *Council to finalise plan for advance side road name sign and forward to TfNSW to confirm design and specifications for order.*
- Additional 50kph speed zone signs to be installed on all approaches to Coolah except the western approach. *Signs ordered by TfNSW and awaiting delivery.*
- TrainLink bus zone to be installed at heavy vehicle parking bay on Bolaro Street, Dunedoo.
- Audit of 'No Parking' Signs in Coonabarabran CBD – 'No Parking' signs to be replaced and installed as per audit.
- 40kph Speed Zones for Coonabarabran and Dunedoo – community feedback to be sought through advertising.
- Extension of double unbroken lines on the Newell Highway from Gardener Street to Dandry Road, Coonabarabran. *Works scheduled with TfNSW Linemarking Crews when next in the area.*
- Installation of Disabled Car Parking Space in Bolaro Street, Dunedoo - further investigations required in relation to a suitable design and location.
- Installation of Pedestrian Crossing in Bolaro Street, Dunedoo – *TfNSW to undertake an assessment.*

### **AGENDA ITEMS**

- a) Warrumbungle Eventing – Change of Date for Closure of Reservoir Street, Coonabarabran for One Day Event – 28 November 2021

**7/2122 RECOMMENDED** that application by Warrumbungle Eventing to close part Reservoir Street, Coonabarabran on Sunday, 28 November 2021 between 9.00am and 3.00pm for the cross-country phase of the One Day Event be approved subject to compliance with Council's Road Closure Guidelines.

b) Speed Limit on Approach to Mendooran – Forest Road and Castlereagh Highway  
Safety concerns were raised regarding the speed limit on the western approach to Mendooran. Vehicles travel through the Castlereagh Highway and Forest Road intersection at 100kph and just prior to the bridge before entering the town the speed limit drops to 50kph. The Committee determined that as the Castlereagh Highway is a State Road the matter be referred to TfNSW for assessment and action.

c) ARTC – Level Crossing on Golden Highway at Dunedoo – markings to discourage vehicles stopping within rail corridor

ARTC have requested a potential safety improvement on the Golden Highway at Sullivan Street Level Crossing in Dunedoo. Traffic has been observed queuing across the rail track behind heavy vehicles waiting to turn right into the Dunedoo Rest Area whilst travelling in a westerly direction. The Committee determined that approval be sought from TfNSW for Council to install yellow box markings and additional signage at the rail level crossing.

d) Central West Cycle Trail – Installation of Finger Post Signage – Mendooran and Dunedoo

**8/2122 RECOMMENDED** that approval in principle be granted to Central West Cycle Trail for installation of CWC finger post signage within the Mendooran and Dunedoo cycle trail subject to clarification of sign design, installation and maintenance costs.
