

## Application to Burn Vegetation - Properties within Warrumbungle Shire Council

Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Regulation 2010

This application form gives consideration of proposals for the burning of dead and dry vegetation (pile burn) within the Warrumbungle Shire Local Government Area. Council grants approval to burn, under clause 13(2) of the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Regulation 2010*. The approval is giving permission to pollute and is not giving permission to light a fire. The owner of the land is to seek additional information/consent from the NSW Rural Fire Service (RFS) or NSW Fire and Rescue (FRNSW) following approval from council.

This approval does not remove the requirement, or exempt the person from the obligation, to obtain relevant permits or licenses under other legislation including the *Rural Fires Act 1997*, *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* and *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*

**PLEASE NOTE:**

- ***This approval does not remove your obligation to obtain a Fire Permit from the NSW Fire and Rescue and NSW Rural Fire Service\****;
- ***This application to burn vegetation only applies to vegetation that is grown on the property;***
- ***Permits to burn vegetation will not be issued when total fire bans have been declared;***
- ***Approval via this form is not required for RFS approved hazard reduction activities.***
- ***The use of incinerators within the Shire is prohibited***

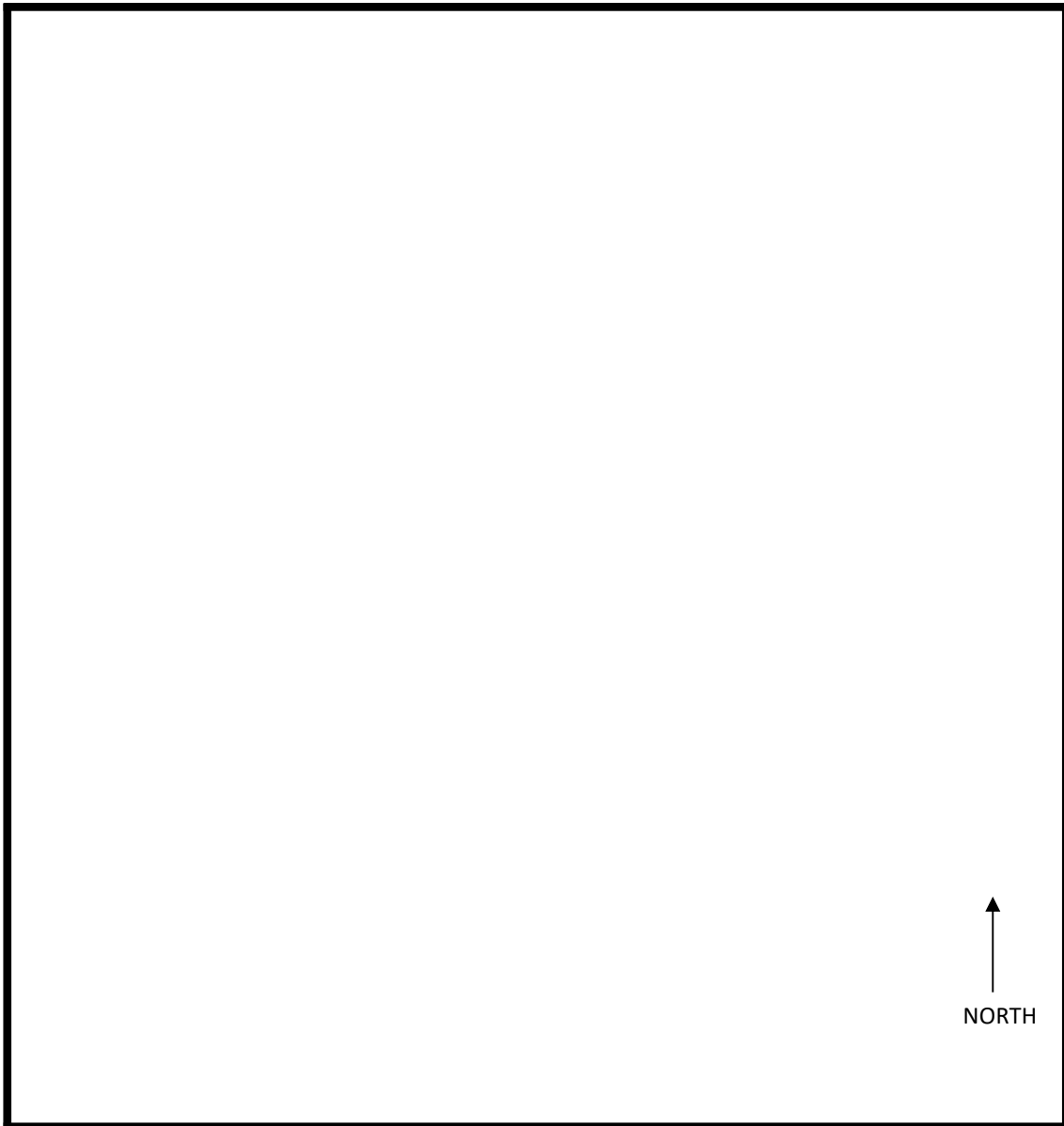
