This Flowchart covers Residents of the Warrumbungle Shire Council who wish to conduct a Hazard Reduction or Agricultural burn within the shire
Hazard Reduction removes the threat of wild fire

You **MUST** notify the Fire Notification Line **1300 557 876** (leave details anytime) and your neighbours **24 hours** before burning **ALL Year round**
