They are parking too close to the corner, which limits a driver’s vision when pulling out of Little Timor Street into Robertson Street. It is a high traffic area, with the preschool and TAFE directly opposite the intersection.</p> <p>ACTION: DTS to list as an agenda item for the Traffic Advisory Committee meeting on 27 April 2023 requesting signage around the intersection.</p>	DTS	<p>18.07.23 – Matter to be tabled at the next Traffic Advisory Committee meeting to be held on 27 July 2023. 30.08.23 – The Traffic Committee resolved that ‘No Stopping’ signs be installed at Little Timor Street and Robertson Street, Coonabarabran in accordance with Standards and at a minimum of 10 metres either side of the intersection.
