How does it work? The smart device displays your current speed as you approach it, giving you a gentle reminder to maintain a safe and appropriate speed within the town limits. It is a friendly nudge to help us all be more mindful and considerate while navigating our charming streets.

"Let's come together as a community to embrace this new addition and create a safer environment for everyone. Spread the word, share the news, and let's celebrate this step towards a safer Shire," said Cr Doolan.

Council has created a schedule for further locations to address speed concerns around the Warrumbungle Shire Local Government Area, with a focus on the school zones in each town. Our next proposed location will be Narren Street, Baradine.

"Remember, it is up to each one of us to make a difference. Let's drive with care, respect our neighbours, and ensure the well-being of our community," Cr Doolan concluded.
